Last academic year the school was oversubscribed. Pupils allocated for September 2016, including appeals: 315

If the school is oversubscribed the following criteria will be applied:

1. Children in Public Care - Looked after children (often known as in care), or children who were previously looked after, but immediately after being looked after became subject to an adoption, residence or special guardianship order.
2. Distance - Pupils living nearest to the school measured using an Ordnance Survey address-point system which measures straight line distances in metres from the address point of the place of permanent residence of the pupil to the address point of the school.

*The admissions process for secondary Transfer 2017 is administered by Halton Borough Council (for Halton residents non Halton residents should refer to their own LA process). This is an online system process using the following schedule:*

- **Closing date for Secondary School Applications: 31st October 2016**
- You must complete a preference form online at [www.halton.gov.uk/schooladmissions](http://www.halton.gov.uk/schooladmissions), where you will be given an e-receipt
- A paper copy of the preference form can also be requested at the Halton Direct Link, but only if you do not have access to the internet
- All online applicants will receive their offer of a school place electronically on the 1st March 2017
- Offer letters will be posted to applicants who submit a paper preference form on 1st March 2017
- Any application made after the deadline date of 31st October 2016, will be considered as late.
