### Sports Day - Date: Tuesday 11th of July 2017

### Equipment Required:

#### Your son/daughter will require the following:

- Full school PE kit (Your son/daughter will be able to attend school in their PE kit rather than their uniform).
- A water bottle to ensure they stay hydrated.
- Trainers.
- Sun Cream will be needed depending on the weather. Please be aware your son/daughter will be outside for the majority of the day and unfortunately sun cream will not be provided by school as we do not have a big enough supply for 1200 pupils.
- You will need to bring a packed lunch or money for their dinner.
- Planners and equipment will be needed for the lesson that they have in their form rooms.

### Timings:

Sports day will follow the same times as a normal school day 8:35am - 2:45pm.

### Reserve date: Thursday 13th July 2017 (In case for any reason that Sports Day is cancelled on Tuesday)

A decision will be made midday on Monday (10th July) by Mr Mitchell (Head of PE) and the school Principal as to whether sports day will go ahead. An email will be sent out to all staff who will be required to inform pupils of the decision.

The school website will also inform parents/pupils as to whether Sports Day will go ahead on the Tuesday.
