6 Top Tips for making notes.

Notes work best with Read, Cover, Write.

Once you have made your notes, read them, cover them up and write them from memory.



Tip 1

Make your notes short and snappy do not copy out every word from the text book

Tip 2

Read the text or information through first and then go through and change then go back and make your notes.

Tip 3

Use coloured pens and highlighters to make notes more fun and colourful

Tip 4

Use different coloured card or paper for different sections and topics

Tip 5

Put an index page at the front of your notes so you can find your notes easily

Tip 6

You don't need to copy every word from the text book. Write down the key information
